

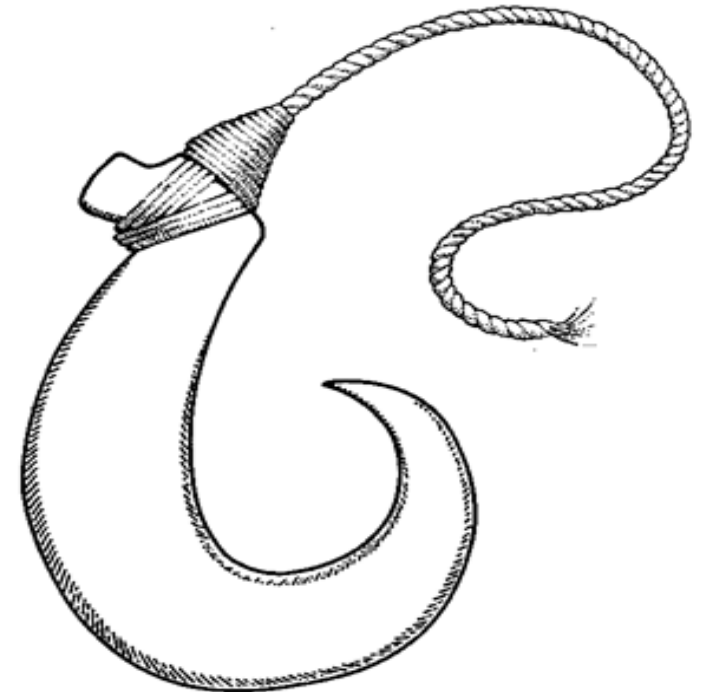


HMS Pandora Objects

The crew of the *Pandora* collected things from the Polynesian people. This fish hook is made from shell and rope.

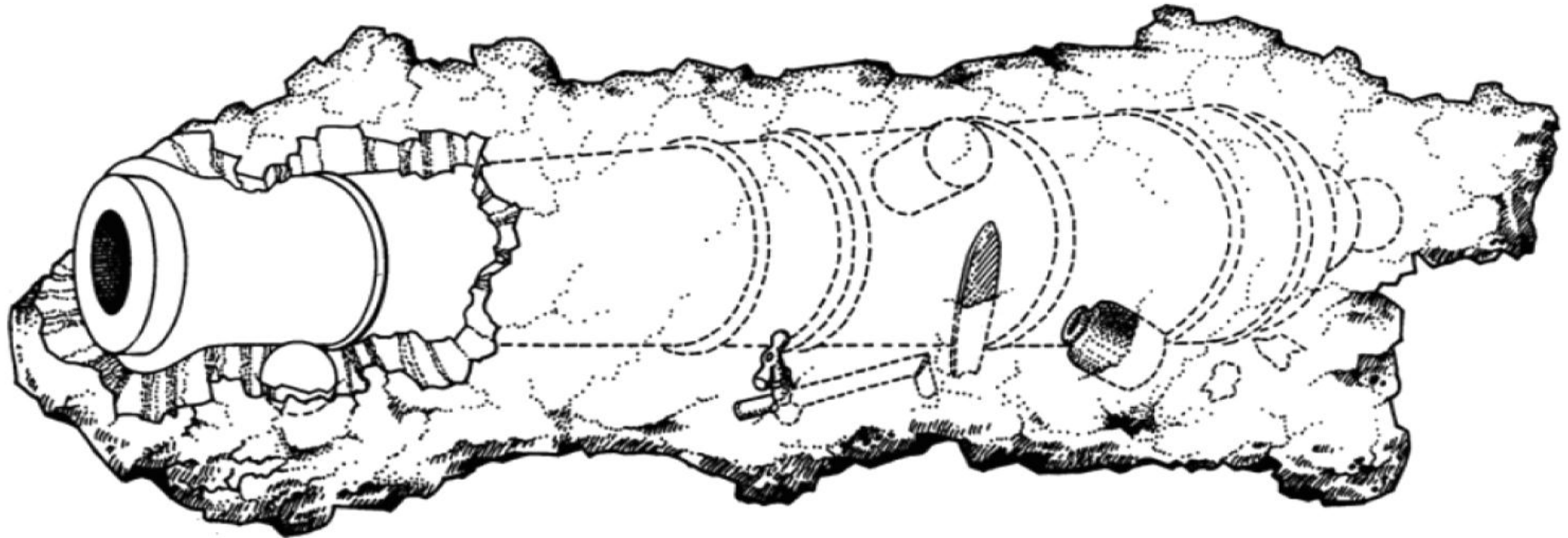




HMS Pandora Objects

shipwreck. It was covered in concretions.

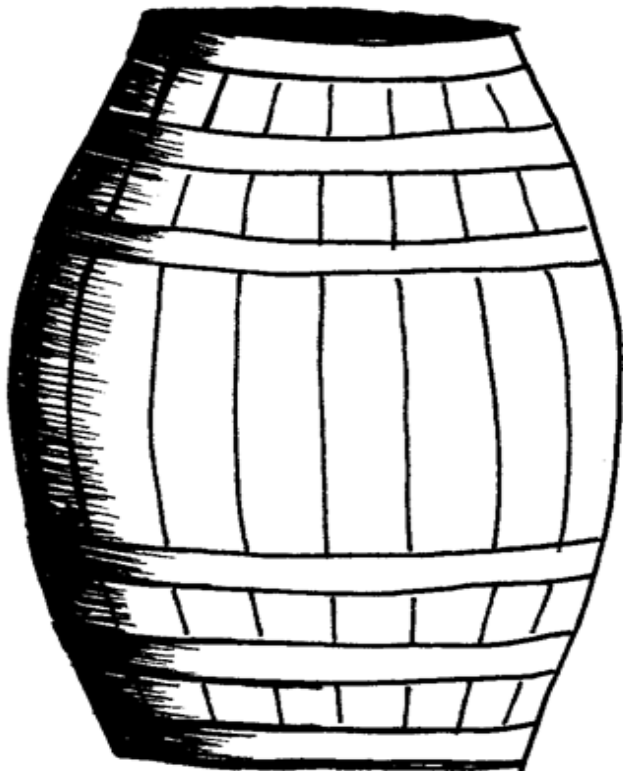

This barrel from the Pandora was used to store food and drink.



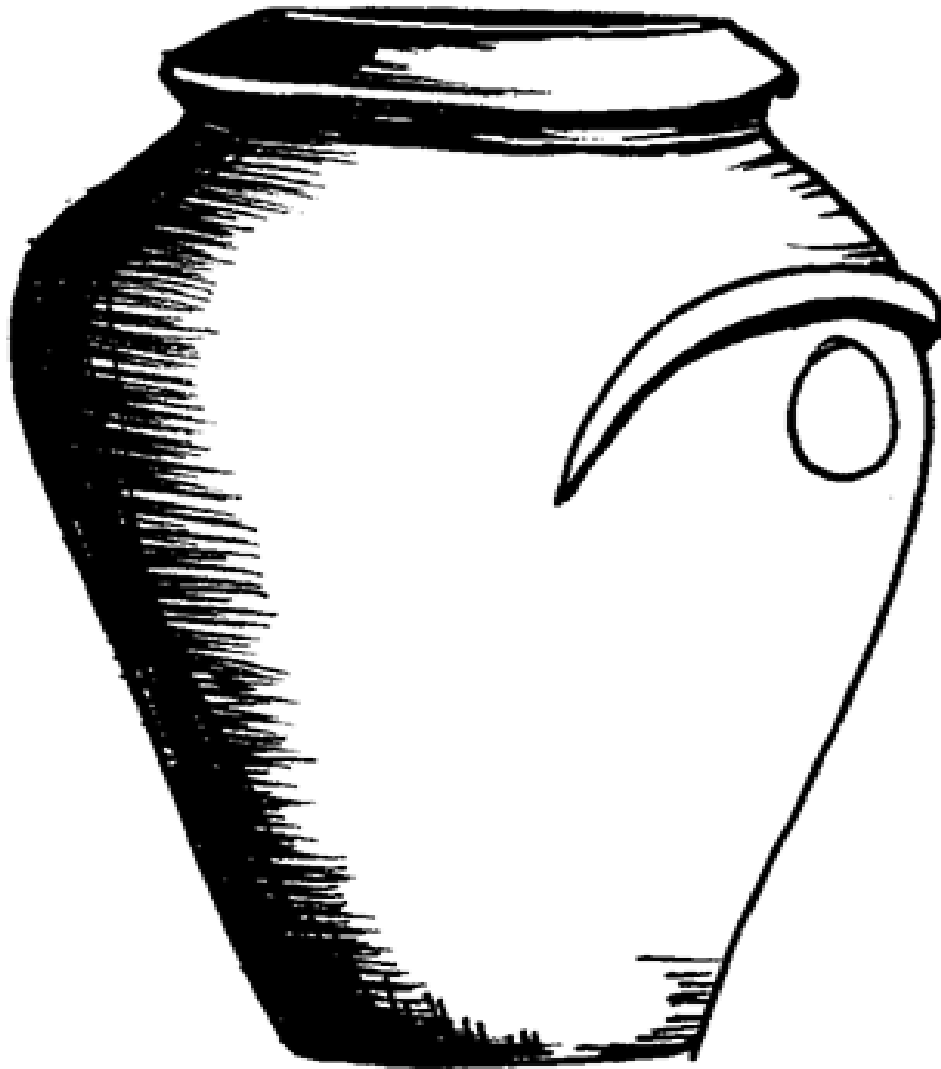
Spruce Jar

Olive oil jar (Ali Baba jar)

This jar originally stored olive oil on the *Pandora*. When the olive oil was used up, it stored tacks, nails, hammer heads and other things.

Cannon ball

The cannons on the *Pandora* used 6 pound cannon balls (2.7kg). They were made of cast iron.

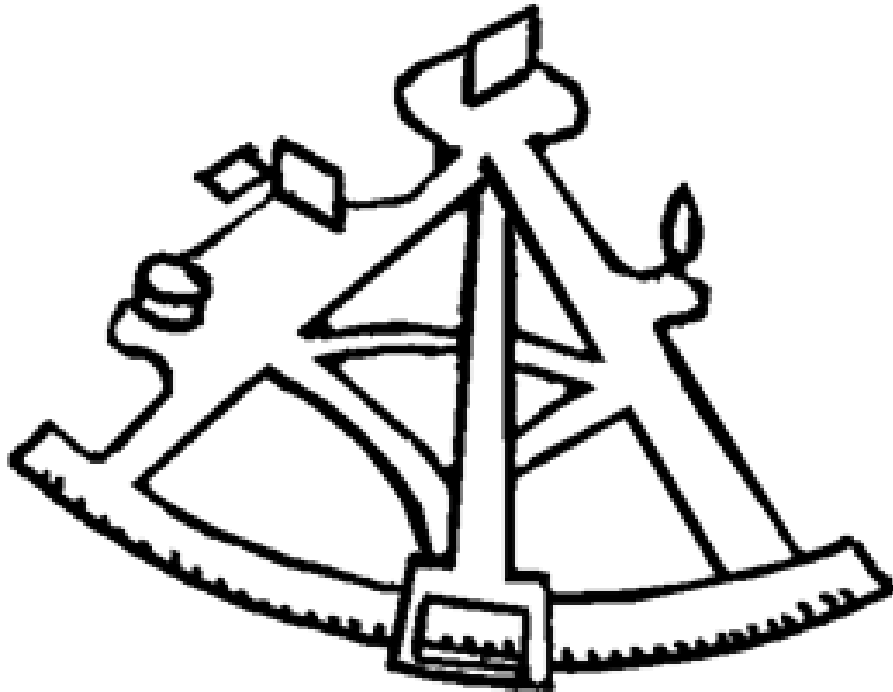
